To request Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law :	20 days after Final Order**		
To file Motion for New Trial :	30 days after Final Order		
To file Notice of Appeal : • Unless request made for MNT or FOFCOL. If request made:	30 days after Final Order 90 days after Final Order		
To file Motion to Extend time for Notice of Appeal: • To be filed contemporaneously with a Notice of Appeal	15 days after Notice of Appeal is due		
For other parties to file Notice of Appeal:	14 days after first Notice of Appeal filed or by any of the deadlines for NOA outlined above, whichever is <u>later</u> .		
For Court to issue Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:	20 days after request		
To have Motion for New Trial heard :	75 days after Final Order		
To file motion for temporary orders pending appeal (appellant): • Unless request made for MNT or FOFCOL. If request made:	30 days after Final Order 90 days after Final Order		
For trial court to hear & sign temporary order pending appeal:	60 days after Notice of Appeal		
To file Motion to Stay Execution :	Before execution of judgement		

^{*} There is no specific statutory reference to a "Motion to Reconsider". However, a trial court retains the power to modify its orders for any reason prior to entry, after which any reconsideration urged by a party must be through a Motion for New Trial.

IN THE COURTS OF APPEALS

To file Appellant's brief :	30 days after reporter and clerks records have been filed.	
To file Appellee's reply brief :	30 days after Appellant's brief	
To file Appellant's reply brief :	20 days after Appellee's brief	
To file Motion for Rehearing :	15 days after court of appeals judgment	
To petition to the Texas Supreme Court: • If Motion for Rehearing is timeline filed:	45 days after court of appeals judgement 45 days after ruling on motion for rehearing
